Developmental Assessment/Diagnostic Evaluation Information

Axis Mundi utilizes standardized diagnostic evaluation/assessment tools and child-led, interactive play sessions to provide a holistic picture of a child's strengths and areas of need. Following completion of evaluations sessions, families meet with the examiner to review diagnostic findings and discuss recommendations for intervention. Intervention recommendations are made based upon the child's unique areas of strength and individual needs and may or may not include services provided by Axis Mundi.

Intake Session – Developmental interview with parent(s)/caregiver(s); Autism Diagnostic Interview, Revised, is administered/coded. The session is a minimum of 2 hours in length and can be held virtually or in-person.

Interactive Play Session – Child-led, play-based session with child and clinician for informal assessment of communication, language, and social engagement skills in low-demand, spontaneous play environment.

Diagnostic Evaluation Session – Administration and coding of Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule, 2nd Edition (ADOS-2); module dependent upon age and acquired language.

Report Writing – Clinical hours for writing of diagnostic report, testing summary, and recommendations for intervention.

Report Findings & Recommendations Meeting – Parent meeting to discuss diagnostic findings and recommendations for intervention.

PAYMENT AND INSURANCE COVERAGE

Axis Mundi does not participate in any insurance plans and is considered an out-of-network provider. Payment is due at each appointment. Payment can be made via check or by credit card on file. It is recommended that families contact their insurance carrier to determine out of network reimbursement benefits prior to scheduling testing. It is important to note that insurance requires a diagnosis be provided in order to provide reimbursement. As diagnostic testing does not provide a guarantee of an autism diagnosis, insurance may deny reimbursement for services rendered if testing findings rule out a diagnosis of autism. Developmental testing with Axis Mundi rules in/out autism as a diagnostic explanation for a child's developmental differences and does not test for additional developmental diversities, such as ADHD and learning differences. If needed, a referral for full neuropsychological testing will be provided.
